

# ORDINANCE NO. 317

The Village Board of Campbellsport, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

## PART 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 23-303, 23-307 and 23-308 (House & Building Numbers) of the Revised Ordinance of the Village of Campbellsport.

## PART 2. PROVISIONS AMENDED

Section 23-303, 23-307 and 23-308 (Block Numbers, Cost of Numbers and Manner of Display) is hereby amended.

## PART 3. PROVISIONS AS AMENDED

Section 23-303, 23-307 and 23-308 –Block Numbers, Cost of Numbers and Manner of Display.

Sec. 23-303. Block numbers.

The numbering for each street shall begin at the baseline. The numbers in the first block shall be from 100 to 199, the second block from 200 to 299, the third block 300-399, etc. There shall be assigned 100 numbers to each block, square or space that would be one block or square, if streets each way were so extended as to intersect each other, and one number shall be assigned to each 25 feet of frontage. In blocks or equivalent space longer than 1,250 feet which is not intersected by a street, the total length of space divided by 50 shall be used to determine the feet of frontage to be assigned each number.

Sec. 23-307. Cost of numbers.

The cost of the number or numbers shall be paid by the owner of the property.

Sec. 23-308. Manner of display.

Numbers to be easily seen. The numbers shall be conspicuously placed immediately above, on, or at the side of the proper door of each building so that the number can be seen from the street. The numbers recommended by our emergency personnel are the panels with 2 and ½ inch numbers that can be purchased at the Village Hall. These numbers are the minimum standard that can be used in the Village. If a property owners wishes to use another style number, it must be at least as large and visible as the panels available at the Village Hall.

If a property has a number that doesn't meet this standard, the owner will be advised to improve the visibility of the property number or replace it with the panel style number.

PART 4.

All ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its introduction and publication as provided by Statute.
