For all contractors doing New Construction or Plumbing Alterations.

The State of Wisconsin is requiring stricter regulations for the Village of Campbellsport Wastewater Discharge Permit. The Wastewater Treatment Facility will be monitoring and trying to reduce the amounts of chlorides in our discharge.

The natural hardness of the Village of Campbellsport water supply to our residents has required many households to have or will be installing water softener systems. This notice is to request your assistance in the reduction of chlorides.

The following items are a few suggestions contractors could implement to help the Village Wastewater Facility to attain acceptable levels:

1. Consider using hard(raw) water to all outside faucets
2. When installing or replacing water softeners, please consider using units with either a sensing element or one that measures gallons of use before re-generating softener.

These procedures will not only reduce re-generations which in turn reduce salt usage and chlorides discharged to system, but will also reduce overall water usage.

Your cooperation in these areas will help the Village of Campbellsport Wastewater Facility in our effort to satisfy permit requirements and also to protect water resources.
