

**** **IMPORTANT NOTICE** ****

TO ALL TAXPAYERS

Due to State of Wisconsin, Department of Revenue policy **NO IMMEDIATE IN PERSON REFUNDS** will be given for payments in excess of full real estate taxes due, under S. 66.0607 Wis. Statutes.

MORTGAGE ESCROW CHECK PROCEDURE

The Village will instead mail a check for the difference to the property owner 7 to 10 working days after receipt of full payment. To receive a refund sooner contact your financial institution and arrange for them to re-issue your escrow funds in two separate checks; one payable to the **TREASURER** of the **VILLAGE** of **CAMPBELLSPORT** for the **EXACT** amount **DUE IN FULL** and the other payable to you for any excess amount.

VILLAGE OFFICE HOURS are 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM Monday - Friday for payments. The **OFFICE** will be **CLOSED** Friday, Dec. 24 & Monday Dec. 27 as well as Friday, Dec. 31 & Jan. 3. We do have a **LOCKED DROP BOX** located by the Poplar St. entrance for **AFTER HOURS PAYMENTS**. All mail dated December 31, 2010 or before will also be accepted as payment for 2010.

****When paying by mail or in the drop box, include a SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE if a receipt is desired.**

Payments made after January 31st for 2nd installment payments should be made payable and sent to: **Fond du Lac County Treasurer, 160 South Macy Street, P.O. Box 1515, Fond du Lac, WI 54936-1515.**

Pursuant to Resolution No. 124-09, adopted by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors on March 16, 2010, 2010, and effective on the 2010 property tax bill, Fond du Lac County will apply a special assessment fee of \$5.00 for each Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System(POWTS) in Fond du Lac County. This annual fee is designed to cover the costs of information collection and administration of the POWTS program.

If you are a tax-exempt organization (i.e. church or governmental unit), you will still receive the charge of \$5.00 per POWTS since this is a special assessment, not a tax. If you feel this information is in error, please call the FDL County Code Enforcement Office at 920-929-3139. Please leave your name, address of the property, phone number, and why you feel this assessment is in error.

BREAKDOWN OF TAX DOLLARS:

The gross tax (Total Rate Assessment) is made up of five different agencies of which the village is a portion. The Village is mandated by law to collect tax on behalf of the other four agencies that cannot issue their own tax bill.
