ARBOR DAY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in April of 2005, Campbellsport's Board of Trustees acknowledged the importance of trees by resolving to develop a community tree management program with a goal of achieving Tree City USA status and applying for grants to help plant and maintain trees in the village;
